II. Six Contrasting Ethical Answers

- 1. Lying is neither right or wrong: there are no laws.
- 2. Lying is generally wrong: there are no universal laws.
- 3. Lying is sometimes right: there is only one universal law. (Love)
- 4. Lying is always wrong: there are many non-conflicting laws.
- 5. Lying is forgivable: there are many conflicting laws.
- 6. Lying is sometimes right: there are higher laws. (Law of Love? Law of Life?)

III. Five Examples of Lying That Saved Lives

- 1. Ex. 1:19 Hebrew midwives lied to Pharaoh and refused to abort the babies.
- 2. Jos. 2 Rahab lied to save the lives of the Israeili spies.
- 3. *Gen.* 12:13 Abram told Sarai to lie to Abimelech so that his life would be spared and he would find favor. (You are my sister half-truth; Sarai was his half-sister. (*Gen.* 20:12)
 - 1. *Gen.* 12:13 Abraham Lied
 - 2. Gen. 20 Lied again to King Gerar
 - 3. Gen. 26 Isaac made Rebekah lie
- 4. Corrie Ten Boom Christian holocaust survivor watched the Nazis torture and kill her sister, Betsy. She lied to save many Jews from the Nazi death camps.
- 5. Lieutenant-Colonel Oliver North (1987) admitted during the U.S. Senate hearings on the Iran-Contra issue that "he had to weigh between lying and lives." In doing so, he saved many innocent lives.

- o Avoid people known to lie -- Prov. 17:4, Ps. 101:7
