- Build Worshipers First
 - Lifestyle Worship | On and Off Stage
 - Musical Worship | Knowing Your Instrument
 - Private Worship | In the Secret Place
 - Public Worship | On Stage

Building a Team

- Build a Structure
 - Foundation kick drum/bass guitar
 - Walls piano or guitar (primary rhythm instrument)
 - Paint, trim, etc. lead guitar, keyboard, woodwinds, and strings.

Building a Team

- Less is more
 - Busy playing is the enemy of beautiful music
 - Develop mature players by teaching them when not to play.

To the Leader

- Know your team: who they are and who they are not.
 - Good players vs. Good-hearted people
 - Good player with a good heart? Please!
 - 2 musicians or 20?
- Communicate to your team.
 - Give them time to grow.
 - Bring correction and direction.
 - Check on the person, not just the team member.
