# MISTAKE #2: SHORT-TERM & SELFISH THINKING

- Rushing the relationship
- Asking for a favor too soon before trust has been established
- Instead focus on building long-term mutually beneficial relationships







### Be a Matchmaker!

- Introduce and connect people who serve the same target audience or who have similar ideal customers
- When your prospective partners see you as someone 'connected' in your industry, you'll establish yourself as someone they'll want to hang around. More importantly, it's FUN to play matchmaker and watch your connections collaborate!


