- Our words have power. They will either build up or tear down.
- Daily confessions of faith keep me strong.

"Put the Word of God in you when you don't need it and it will be there when you do need it." - Pastor Tommy Burchfield. By now, you've probably heard this quote several times. This is a GOOD thing. One of the most powerful things that God has given us are words, but not just *our* words. I'm talking about turning God's words into our words. You can change your day, your circumstances, and even your life by choosing to speak God's words in your life. How amazing it is that you could wake up one morning feeling grumpy and grouchy and speak God's joy and strength into your own mind and body!

It's also amazing that we can speak God's words of healing into hurting situations. You'll never regret filling your mouth with powerful confessions of faith. We have the power to confess what we want to see manifested in our lives. The Bible says in Proverbs 18:21 that "life and death are in the power of the tongue." The tongue is a small bodily member, but it can cause either great destruction or great blessing. Faith confessions build up truth and break down lies.

Make it a daily habit to confess faith, and watch mountains move and blessings come.

## **Supporting Statements:**

- Confessing God's truth in faith will continue to push out the enemy's lies.
- Even in challenging times, we should use the faith in our words to give thanks to God simply for who He is.
- Speak life into dead situations by faith.
- Build yourself up daily with confessions of faith, and you won't get knocked out when storms come your way.
- Confessions of faith create a pathway for good things to come and negative things to leave.
