Week 9: THE GREAT COMMISSION

Daily I **WILL** seek to disciple others.

- *Jesus gave us all a mission called The Great Commission.*
- *I am a disciple and also a disciple maker.*
- *Mentor, model, and teach others how to obey Jesus' commands.*

We all have individual callings, but we all have been given the same mission. We don't need to sit around waiting for more instructions from God. We've already been given plenty to do, and that's where we should start. We have all been commissioned to go out and make more and more disciples. This is one of the easiest ways to obey God's commandment of being fruitful and multiplying. Learn to walk in the ways of Jesus and then teach others to do it as well. Multiply yourself!

The first step is to share the Gospel with someone by telling them with your words; then, show the Gospel to someone with your life. We do this by leading others into entering a relationship with Jesus Christ, mentoring someone, and helping to teach others how to obey the teachings of Jesus that we build our lives upon. This requires intentionality. Making disciples doesn't happen by accident. We must be purposeful about initiating conversations and taking action steps that make room for sharing the Gospel with others. Look at the people around you and see who you can teach today.

Supporting Statements:

- We all have a duty to disciple others. It's not a suggestion, but a command.
- God trusts you to show others how to live a Godly life.
- Freely you have received guidance through the teaching of Jesus. Freely we ought to teach others.
- The whole world needs to know about Jesus. That is accomplished by each one of us discipling our world.
- You are on Team Jesus now, and it's Mission "POSSIBLE."
