



## THE LAW OF LOVE The Right Answer Every Time

The Law of Love is the guiding motive behind every action of a Christian leader. (II Cor. 5:14)

The Right Question: How would the love of God respond to this?

The Right Answer: The Law of Love is the highest law and will always be the right answer.

- I. The Law of Love Puts Others First
  - The Good Samaritan "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart.. .and love your neighbor as yourself." Lk.10:27
    - 1. Jesus established our moral priority towards others in Luke 10:25-38 and clearly equated our love for God as seen in how we treat others.

    - 3. Leadership Lessons From A Trick Question ("Who is my neighbor?")
      - We show our love for God by how we treat others.
        - Jesus commended compassion, not religious rules.
        - Your neighbor is whoever needs help.
        - Your neighbor's needs transcend the politically correct and socially accepted status quo.

- II. The Law Of Love Towards Younger Christians
  - Jesus' Serious Warning Mt. 18:6, Mk. 9:42, Lk. 17:2

"But whoever causes one of these little ones to sin, it would be better for him if a millstone was hung around his neck, and he were drowned in the depth of the sea."

- 1. Millstone -- circular stones used for grinding grain or other substance. The 20" version were used by women, but the larger, heavier versions, which were 6' x 8" required the strength of an animal and weighed up to 3/4 of a ton. Jesus referred to the larger version in Mt. 18:6
- Leadership Lessons
  - 1. How we live matters.
  - 2. Our actions influences others; especially those younger in the Lord
  - 3. Our actions influences others; especially those carnal or lacking spiritual maturity.
  - 4. Any action on the part of a Christian which would influence, encourage or aid a younger Christian to sin.
  - 5. When in doubt, don't.
  - 6. Young Christians are especially susceptible to being disillusioned by your complaints or critical attitudes towards spiritual leadership.
