

Scriptures Concerning Preaching

- Matthew 28:19-20 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.
- 2 Timothy 2: 24-26 "And The Lord's <u>servant</u> must not be quarrelsome but <u>must be kind</u> to <u>everyone</u>, <u>able to teach</u>, not resentful.
- Acts 10:42 "He appointed and commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that He is the One whom God appointed as judge of the living and the dead."
- Romans 1:16 "For <u>I am not ashamed of the Gospel</u>, for it is the <u>power of God</u> for salvation, to <u>everyone who</u> <u>believes</u>, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
- 2 Timothy 4:2 " <u>Preach The Word</u>. <u>Be ready</u> in season and out of season; <u>reprove</u>, <u>rebuke</u>, and <u>exhort</u>, with complete <u>patience</u> and <u>teaching</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 9:16 "For if I preach the Gospel, that gives me no ground for boasting. For necessity is laid upon me. Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel!
- Luke 4:43 "But He said to them, "I must preach the Good News of the Kingdom of God to the other towns as well; for I was sent for this purpose.""
- 1 Timothy 4:13 "Until I come, <u>devote yourself</u> to the <u>public reading of Scripture</u>, to <u>exhortation</u>, to <u>teaching</u>."



- Acts 28:31 <u>Proclaiming the Kingdom of God</u> and <u>teaching about The Lord Jesus Christ</u> with all <u>boldness</u> and without hindrance"
- Ephesians 2:17 "He came and <u>preached peace to you</u> who were <u>far off</u> and peace to those who were near.
- Romans 10:14-15 ... "how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!"
- 1 Corinthians 1:23 "But we preach Christ crucified"...
- Titus 1:3 "And at the proper time manifested in his word through the preaching with which I have been entrusted by the command of God our Saviour;"
- 1 Corinthians 2:13 "And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual.
- Colossians 4:6 "Let your <u>speech always be gracious</u>, seasoned with salt, so that you may <u>know</u> how you ought to <u>answer</u> each person.
- 2 Corinthians 4:5 "For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake.
- Luke 9:60 "Jesus said to him, "Leave the dead to bury their own dead." But as for you, go and proclaim the <u>Kingdom of God.</u>""
