# WHERE DID ANXIETY COME FROM?

I believe we can trace back anxiety even to the people of the Bible, but let's just start with the more recent family tree. Anxiety could absolutely be passed down in your family from generation to generation. But, that's not everyones story. It could have started at your childhood without you even being aware of it. Let's unpack this together.

### GENERATIONAL HEIRLOOMS

What's an heirloom? An heirloom is something that has "belonged" to a family for several generations. So, anxiety could have been something that was passed down to you that your family carried. I heard the Holy Spirit tell me, "Anxiety was an heirloom, but a sound mind is your inheritance." Receive that inheritance in the Name of Jesus, right now! Anxiety crept in, and made it's home in your heart. For so long you didn't know why such deep thoughts crossed your mind. You've carried something so heavy, and it manifested in the form of physical anxiety. If you never recieved that apology. here it is. I am so sorry.

I am so sorry someone took advantage of you, your heart, and your vulnerability. I can't say anything to undo it all, but I know a Father that is wrapping His purely loving arms around you in this moment. Trade the unfair and tragic memories for His sweet redemption, in Jesus Name!



# WHAT IS ANXIETY?

Anxiety, in my experience, comes down to one thing. The need to be in control of the outcome of everything. Anxiety comes out in different forms, let's unpack some examples together.

### THE OVERTHINKING

Have you ever had a thought, and that thought led to another thought, and another one? Think Dominos. One thought creating a spiraling reaction. I'm not talking aboout your grocery list, "milk, oh yeah apples, and bread." No, driving in the car, and "what if that car hits me, who would call my husband, who would watch my kids while he comes to help me out?" You get the point. The overthinking. *Isaiah*

### THE WORRY

So much is happening in the world today, and it's easy to "worry" about the future. We worry about our kids, and their future. We worry about that extra bill that popped up this month, or how we're gonna get all the household chores done by the end of the day. 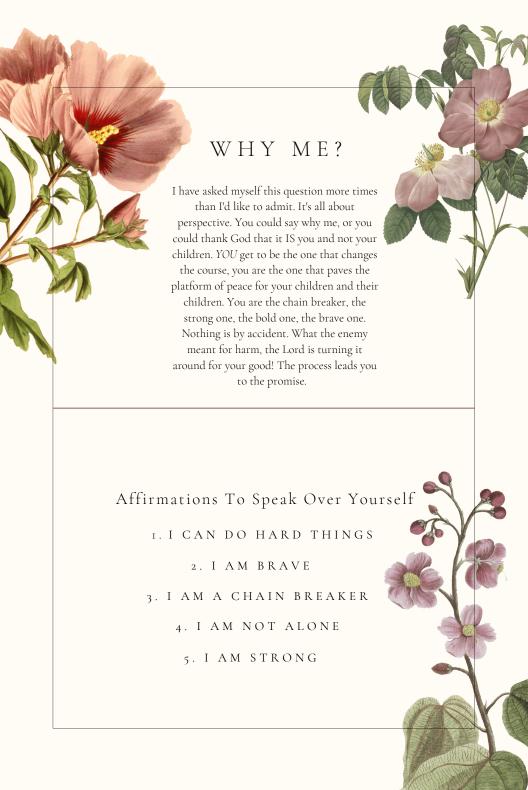


### PRACTICAL TIPS

- i. Breathe. Stop whatever you're doing and take time to focus on your breathing. Breathe in, and breathe out.
- 2. Turn up the worship music. Keep it soft and gentle. Make a playlist for these moments so you can go straight to it, and aren't flipping through songs. Turn your worry into worship.
- 3. Pray. Tell Jesus everything. Say it out loud. Cast your cares upon Him (not your mom, husband, wife, sister, brother, or friend) because HE cares. Be careful not to work yourself up again, just tell Jesus what's on your heart. He cares.
- 4. Replace the lie. Ask yourself "what do I KNOW to be true about this situation," and start speaking life over your situation, speak truth out loud, when you say it out loud you're telling your mind, body, and soul to LINE UP with TRUTH.
- 5. Process. This might be right after your moment, this might be hours later but just process. This will look different for everyone. Write out what triggered you, the situation that took place, the lies and the truths. Maybe it might look like processing with a family, friend, or Jesus. If you have a spouse, grab a drink when the kids are down and process together that moment. Worship is also a form of processing. Whatever you do, just get it out. If it stays in, you give it the power to become a building block again.
