Anger

"For I the Lord love justice; I hate robbery and wrong with violence. I will faithfully give them their recompense." (Isaiah 61:8)

Peace

"Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace among all people, with whom He is well pleased." (Luke 2:14)

Joy

"In his presence is fullness of joy, at your right hand their are pleasures for evermore." (Psalm 16:11)

Empathy

"The Lord said, I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering." (Exodus 3:7)

Hope

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace." (Romans 15:3)

Sadness
