Take a few minutes to worship each attribute and meditate on it throughout the day, i.e., "Oh God, I worship You today because You are good."

Good - He always does what is right and beneficial by releasing the appropriate part of His character to your specific situation.

Eternal - Without beginning or end, transcending all limitations of time. Since nothing but God is eternal, nothing but God is worth loving.

Almighty - "El Shaddai," the All-powerful One with the ability and authority to rule.

Compassionate - To have mercy and kindness with intensity of will and readiness of mind.

Holy - Set apart, sacred, worthy of reverence, absolute moral purity, unstained by sin or evil.

Faithful - We can trust Him to do what He says He will do. Out of His faithfulness, God honors His covenants and fulfills His promises.

Merciful - Forbearing and forgiving, although undeserved by the recipient.

Worthy - Uniquely qualified, infinitely valuable, and deserving of our respectful worship.

Unchanging - Immutable, unchanging in His character, will, and covenant promises; He is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Just - Perfectly righteous in His treatment of His creatures; impartially judges in always right and good ways.

Restorer - Better than before; to bring something back to (at least) its originally intended purpose

Truth - The standard for reality as perceived by God; He cannot and will not lie.

Victorious - Unconquerable and able to deliver from all things contrary to His character
