

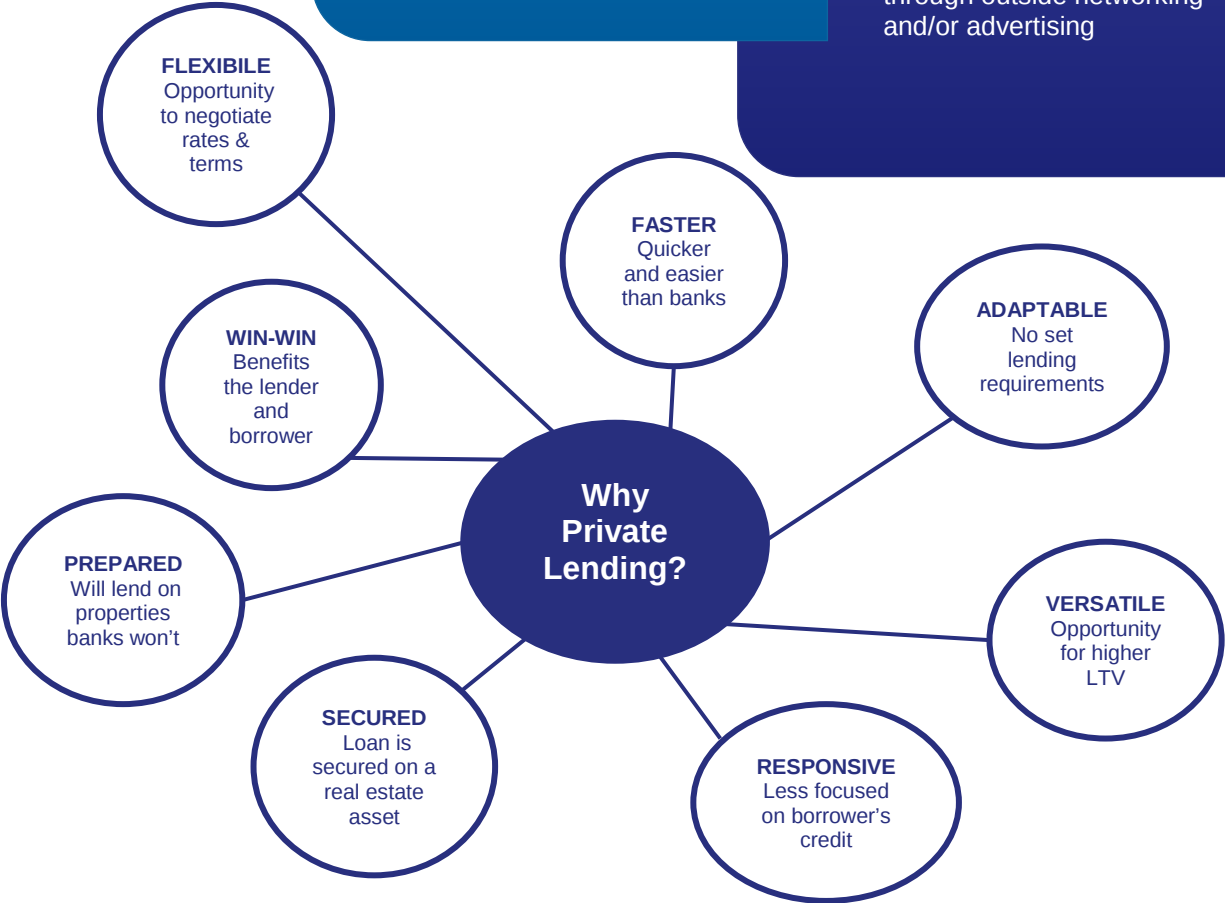
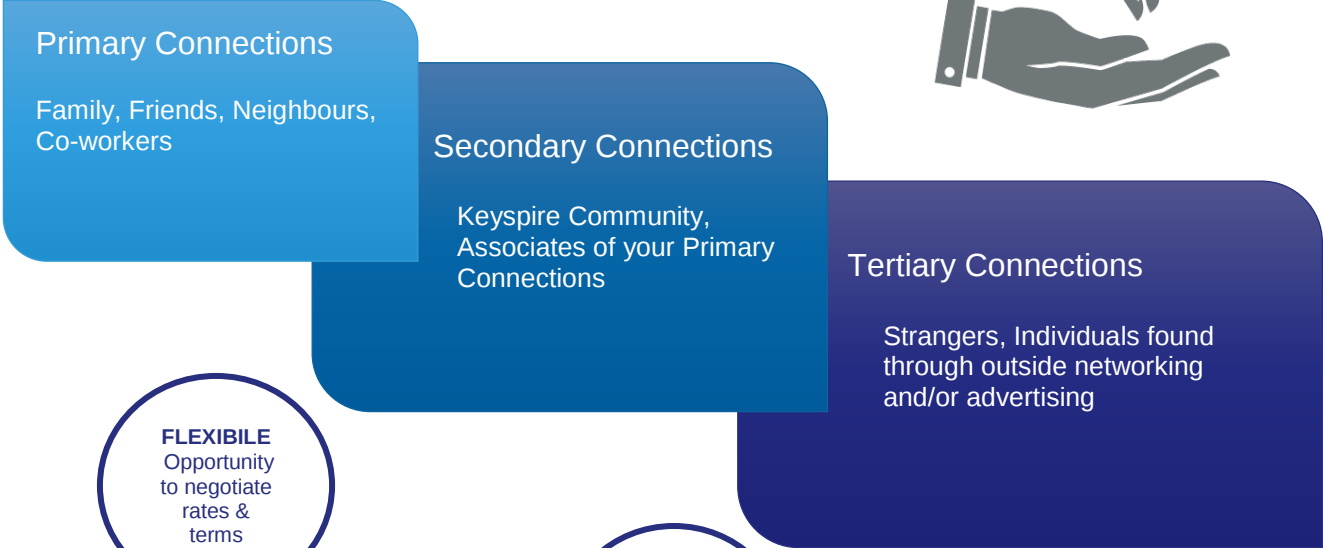
The Power of Private Lending
