#	Routine	Prompt	Permission	Practice	Person
1	Reset to Rest	When stress, worry, or anxiety are trying to gain access to my life...	"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you... Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." (John 14:27)	I let the peace of Christ rule. I call up His peace in me because the Prince of Peace lives in me. Peace is a ruling power in my life.	I am an untroubled and calm leader who lives in permanent peace, knowing stress and worry are unnecessary with His rest.
2	New Every Morning	When compounding negatives and yesterday's issues are weighing on me...	"The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases... they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." (Lamentations 3:22-23)	I close each day with Him and start fresh every morning, leaving yesterday behind and expecting His goodness today.	I am becoming a Kingdom leader by starting every day fresh in the Lord, upgrading my expectations of His goodness.
3	New Creation	When my old self tries to remind me of who I used to be or who I am not...	"If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away; behold, new things have come." (2 Corinthians 5:17)	I only work on my new self because the old me is dead. I practice walking in my new nature in Christ.	I am becoming like Jesus, living in His new nature given to me through the cross.
4	Lightness	When I feel my burden is heavy...	"Come to me, all you who are weary... and I will give you rest... my yoke is easy and my burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30)	I reset to rest and ask Jesus how our partnership works in my situation, activating my Yoke with Him.	I am a leader whose yoke is easy, and burden is light, always guided by Jesus.
